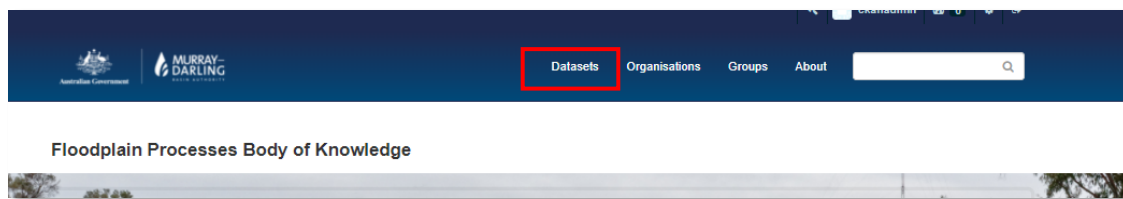
Finding data

The Basin of Knowledge has three main ways to search for datasets, including:

- Selecting the dataset tab and scrolling through each resource separately
- Using keyword searches, including applying filters and using advanced search, and
- Selecting a focus group icon to search for a current featured topic

Listing all the data in the dataset catalogue

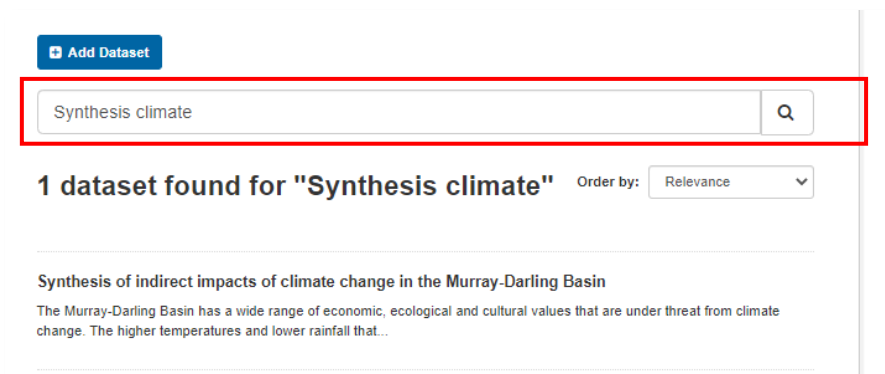
To list all the datasets available to the user in this catalogue, simply select the 'Datasets' link below.



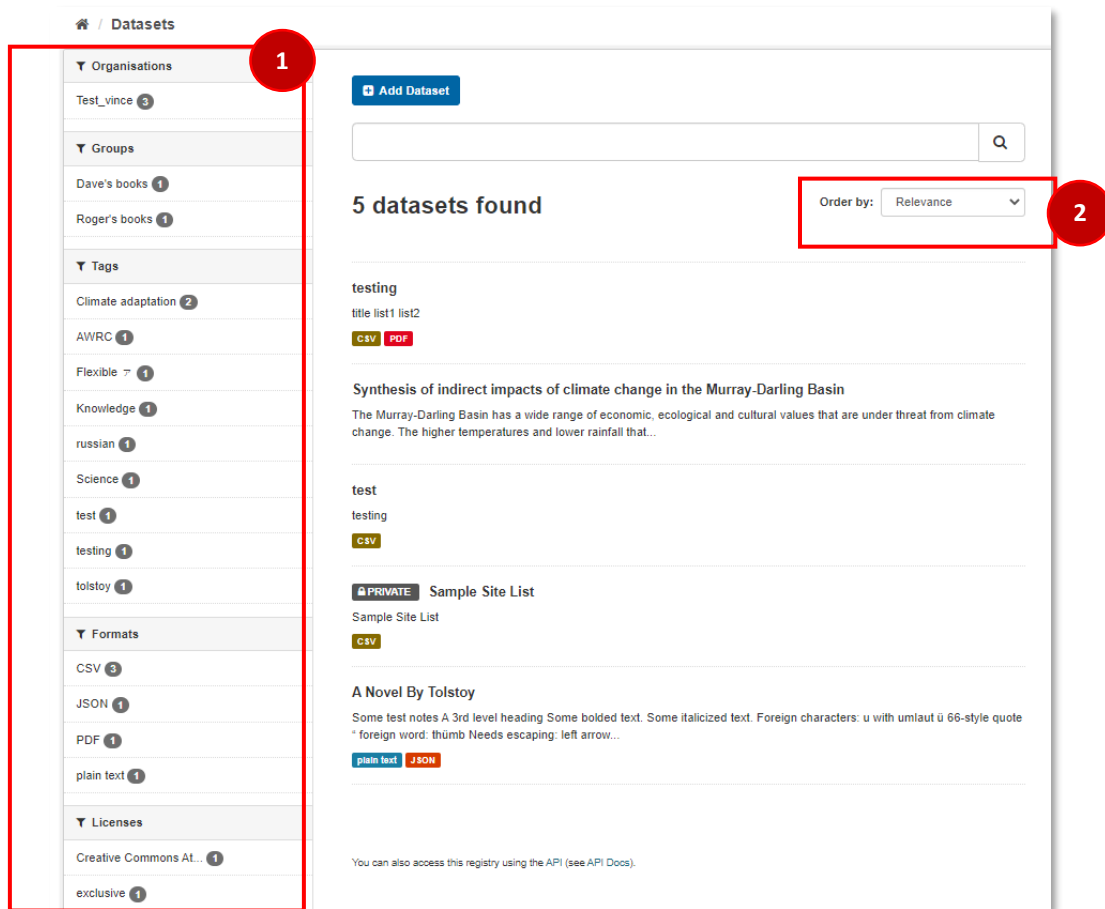
There are several methods to assist (refine) the search:

- View individual datasets
- Refine the search by adding keywords to the search bar
- Apply several search filters, and
- Reorder the search results

Datasets are listed in the main body of the page; you may need to scroll down or view multiple pages to view all results. To refine your search, simply add or remove keywords from the search box below.

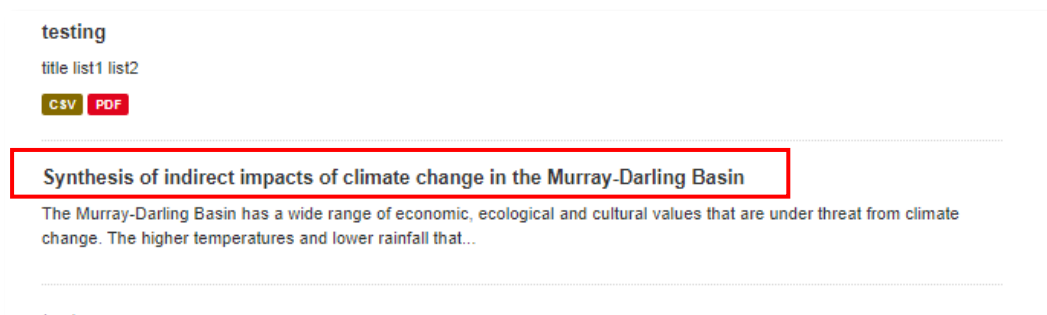


1. To filter your search, select from the below options, including Organisation, Groups, Tags, File Formats, and licence type.
